

"RF" Rate
Residential & Farm Service
Effective September 1, 2015
210, 410, 14

Availability

This rate is available for all residential electrical uses, plus any single-phase farm-related electrical usage. To qualify for this rate, this account meter must serve a single-family full-time residence.

Character of Service

The type of service rendered under this rate shall be limited to single-phase, sixty (60) Hertz, and at standard 120/240 voltage.

Rate -- Monthly

Facilities Charge:	\$20.00 per month
Energy Charge:	
First 500 kilowatt-hour usage per month	\$.1105 per KWH
Next 1000 kilowatt-hour usage per month	\$.1026 per KWH
All over 1,500 kilowatt-hour usage per month	\$.0905 per KWH

Minimum Monthly Charge

- The minimum monthly billing charge under this rate shall be the Facilities Charge, or
- A minimum charge as may be specified in a supplemental contract between the REMC and member.

Conditions of Service

- This rate is limited to residential and incidental farm-related usage. Should the non-residential usage on the billing meter be non-farm related, the billing rate shall be GS, whether or not a residence is served by this meter.
- This rate has no transformer size limitation; however a full-time single-family residence must be recorded on this meter.
- This rate is limited to single-phase service, with an individual electric motor limited to a maximum of 10 horsepower, unless approved by Heartland REMC.
- This rate requires continuous service. Where the electrical load is not deemed "primarily seasonal" by Heartland REMC, and the account is disconnected for less than 12 months, all minimum monthly charges avoided during the disconnected period, plus a re-connect trip charge, shall be paid prior to re-establishing the account in the same name or that of another family member.

- Should the electrical energy furnished under this rate schedule be metered on the primary side of the service transformer(s), Heartland REMC shall deduct 1½% of the total energy revenue for that billing month.
- This rate is applicable to the “Delivered” energy that flows from the grid to the member equipment. When a renewable energy generation resource is interconnected to the Heartland REMC electric system, this rate shall not apply to the “Received” energy that flows back onto the grid. Assuming that an interconnection agreement is in place, “Received” energy shall be paid at “Avoided Cost” which will be adjusted from time to time.

Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment

The above rates are subject to purchased power cost tracking adjustments as charged to Heartland REMC by its power supplier.
